OVERVIEW

SRE Network serves as a multiplier through our community investments portfolio, which encompasses grantmaking and investments in partnerships with experts, trainers, and practitioners in the Jewish community and beyond to provide support to SRE Network members, Jewish workplaces, and the field at large.

To date, SRE Network has invested over \$7M in six years in grants to over 61 organizations and 124 unique projects to advance safety, respect, and equity with a focus on addressing gender-based harassment, discrimination, and inequity.

In 2024, SRE Network awarded a total of \$845,000 to nineteen SRE member organizations through fall capacity building grants and spring field building grants.
